

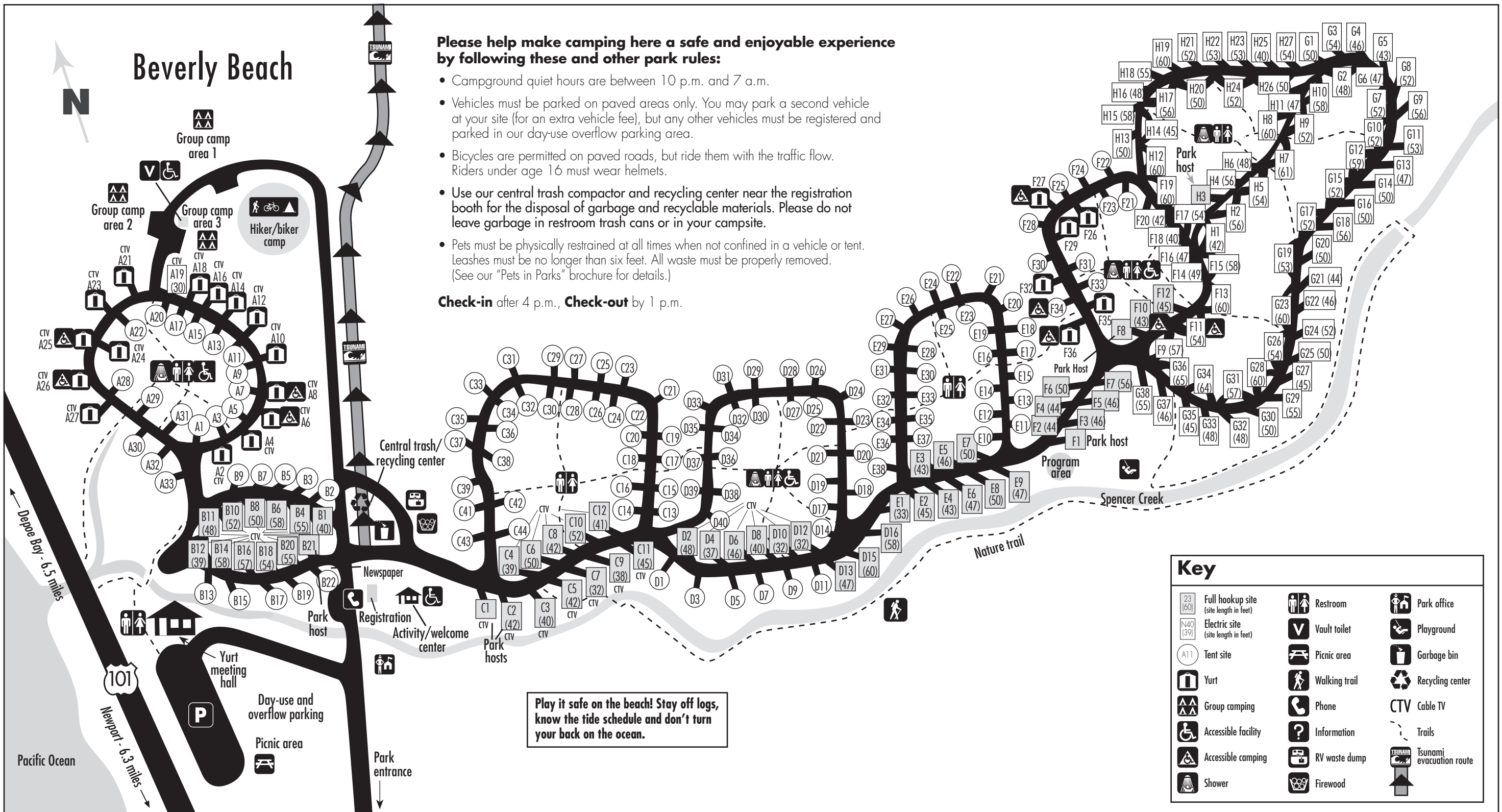
# Beverly Beach

## Please help make camping here a safe and enjoyable experience by following these and other park rules:

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Vehicles must be parked on paved areas only. You may park a second vehicle at your site (for an extra vehicle fee), but any other vehicles must be registered and parked in our day-use overflow parking area.
- Bicycles are permitted on paved roads, but ride them with the traffic flow. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
- Use our central trash compactor and recycling center near the registration booth for the disposal of garbage and recyclable materials. Please do not leave garbage in restroom trash cans or in your campsite.
- Pets must be physically restrained at all times when not confined in a vehicle or tent. Leashes must be no longer than six feet. All waste must be properly removed. (See our "Pets in Parks" brochure for details.)

**Check-in** after 4 p.m., **Check-out** by 1 p.m.

**Play it safe on the beach! Stay off logs, know the tide schedule and don't turn your back on the ocean.**
