

Issues and Proposals in the 1997 Draft Master Plan for South Beach State Park

Issues raised in 1997 Issues Scoping Meetings:

- Protection of important views, habitat & foredune.
- Adequate maintenance, management , supervision.
- Facilities to accommodate peak season growth and encourage more non-peak use.
- Providing equestrian beach access while avoiding conflicts with other uses.
- Providing river access consistent with Army Corps requirements.
- Providing support facilities near the jetty, e.g., day use parking, camping, sanitary facilities, road improvements.
- Providing more internal & external trail connections.
- Providing for group uses, e.g., meeting halls.
- Some want place for non-traditional uses, e.g. ballfields.

Proposals in the 1997 Draft Master Plan:

- Jetty Road Area:
 - Road improvements
 - Day use parking
 - Restrooms
 - Long vehicle parking & turnaround
 - Self contained camping
 - Multi-use hall
 - River access structures
- Campground area:
 - yurt area
 - yurts in camp loops
 - tent camp loop
 - meeting hall in camp loops
 - meeting hall in group camp
 - relocated camp talk area
 - camper info station
- Trails & trail connections
- Event facility, if additional property acquired
